Have Bonus, Will Botox

Bankers in London are spending their bonuses in an unusual way. They are choosing cosmetic surgery to look younger because the job market is very <u>competitive</u>. The bankers are choosing nose jobs, wrinkle fillers, liposuction, and botox <u>injections</u> to slow the effects of age.

Operations increased to more than 22,000 last year, and both men and women are getting cosmetic surgery. In fact, men make up eleven percent of this total, and the percentage has increased every year.

Mel Braham, <u>chairman</u> of the Harley Medical Group, said that more men realize they need to look good. He explained that older men worry about their jobs, <u>especially</u> if they are 50 years old but look like they are 60. That person doesn't want a younger person to take his job. Braham also added that men should start these <u>treatments</u> early to look younger and healthier for a longer period of time.

Most men are asking to change the shape of their nose or get rid of their love handles. But there may soon be a remedy for baldness too. This would <u>expand</u> the business of cosmetic surgery for men even more.

At the moment, prices range from £200 for botox injections to £6000 for a facelift.
